



Call for Applications for the Awarding of Scholarships for Future Students of Bachelor's or Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programs 2022/2023 Academic Year – Chinese Gaokao students

Luiss Guido Carli's education model, defined as **life large learning**, combines a solid specialist preparation with a broader, wider, inclusive, cultural approach as a whole, attentive to current issues of innovation, sustainability, circular economy, ethical and social thinking, in increasingly open and interconnected ecosystems. The aim is to encourage the students' natural intellectual curiosity so that, through individual effort, they can discover themselves and develop independent and critical thinking that can ensure an immediate social impact in concrete terms and is the result of the right blend between individual learning and ability to work in a team.

With this in mind, the University relies on an innovative education model, **enquiry-based learning**, which is based on the development of a synergy between the students' spirit of research and academic education, and focuses on the students' ability to ask questions, to investigate phenomena, in a logic that enhances critical thinking and problem solving. The aim is to involve and expose students to the learning of multiple disciplines through various and different study opportunities and a wide spectrum of curricular and extra-curricular activities.

The goal of Luiss Guido Carli, therefore, is to educate new professional figures capable of covering the roles of future leaders able to respond to digital challenges as well as those in relation to sustainability. In order to foster the selection of the most deserving students, the University announces a competition for the awarding of **merit-based** scholarships earmarked for Chinese Gaokao students who will enroll at Luiss Guido Carli for the first year of a bachelor's degree or single-cycle master's degree program in the 2022/2023 academic year.

The scholarships consist of a **full waiver of the annual contribution fee** and can include free accommodation and meal vouchers for the Luiss canteen. The meal vouchers not used for Luiss canteen are non-refundable.

1. Eligibility

The competition is opened to students who have successfully submitted the online application form for direct admission to bachelor's or single-cycle degree programs, given their Gaokao total score. The selection process will take place from 20 June to 25 July 2022.

The aid envisaged by this competition is incompatible with other total or partial tuition fee waivers or scholarships held for any reason whatsoever for the same academic year, except for those awarded by Italian or foreign institutions designed to support, through periods abroad, a student's education for the academic years covered by this competition.

2. Criteria for Awarding the Aid

Scholarships are assigned at the discretion of the Admission Board to candidates participating in the Gaokao selection process. Therefore, students will be automatically considered for a scholarship through the admission application, according to the instructions set out by the Selection for Gaokao students.

Should the student be awarded with a scholarship based on academic merit will be informed via email according to the following deadlines:

- 8 July 2022
- 18 July 2022
- 26 July 2022

The student will have 48 hours to accept the scholarship by answering the email. In case it will not be communicated the acceptance of the scholarship by the given deadline, the student will not receive the scholarship.

3. Renewal of the Aid

The full tuition fee waiver may be renewed for the entire standard duration of the degree program on condition that the student, by the end of the summer exam session of each year, has earned at least 70% of the education credits required under their study plan for graduation purposes and also has a weighted average grade of not less than 27/30.

The scholarships will be assigned until graduation, which must take place within the first available degree session. After this deadline, if the student has not graduated, the stay at the University residences will be guaranteed at the expense of the student.

4. Revocation

The aid envisaged by this competition will be revoked upon the occurrence of any one of the following:

- the student discontinues their studies;



- the student is eligible for the Disco Lazio regional competition for the awarding of scholarships;
- the student transfers to another university;
- the student fails to enroll at LUISS Guido Carli.
