



Notice of competition for the awarding of scholarships reserved for students participating in the Foundation Programme in the 2023/2024 academic year.

1. Subject matter of the competition

Luiss University aims to inspire meaningful change in society by educating a new generation of successful students and graduates. To this end, the University invests in inclusion, social mobility and collective leadership by going beyond conventions, roles and goals to transform boundaries into horizons.

Our mission is to create a future fueled by an intertwining of knowledge, cultures, responsibility and passion. Social, cultural and gender diversity and sustainable development in the circular economy and in digitalization are the guiding principles in taking action for international students. Welcoming international students is one of our most important values, which is why Luiss University is making four scholarships available for the 2023/2024 academic year for students taking part to the Foundation Programme, giving priority to:

- Students coming from conflict or natural disaster zones or areas.

2. Scholarship amount

The scholarships consist of partial or total waivers of the University's annual tuition fee excluding the payment of taxes levied by the State or the Lazio Region.

The partial waiver will be applied to the second installment up to the amount granted. If a total scholarship is granted, students will receive a refund of the first instalment within 30 days from the beginning of the Foundation Programme 2023/2024.

There are no additional benefits beyond the aid envisaged by this competition. Anything not expressly stated when awarding the scholarship is the student's own responsibility.

3. Eligibility

This competition is open to all students enrolling at Luiss Foundation Programme during the academic year 2023/2024 at Luiss University.



4. Incompatibility

The aid envisaged by this competition is incompatible with other tuition fee waivers or scholarships held for any reason whatsoever.

5. Participation in the Competition and Awarding of the Scholarship

Students admitted as part of the international selection process for enrollment in the Foundation Programme in the 2023/2024 academic year will be evaluated for the purpose of awarding the scholarships upon student's request in the form of application [available at this link](#).

The Admissions Commission in charge of deciding on the admissions, composed by members of the International Orientation and the Admission Offices, together with the Course Director, will communicate the names of candidates evaluated deserving of scholarships. Students selected for the assignment of scholarship will receive communication of selection in due time.

The deadline for the request of scholarship is on September 10th, 2023. For more information on the deadline for the application to Luiss Foundation Programme, students should read the call for application for admission available on Luiss website.

Winning students will receive a communication by e-mail about the instructions for accepting or not accepting the aid by September 14th, 2023. Failure to accept by the deadline stated in the e-mail will result in automatic revocation of the awarded scholarship, in which case the scholarship will be reallocated.

6. Revocation

The aid envisaged by this competition will be revoked upon the occurrence of any one of the following:

- the student fails to enroll in the Luiss University Foundation Programme to which they have been admitted for the 2023/2024 academic year;
- the student discontinues their studies by not fulfilling the attendance requirement of at least 80% of each course's attendance.
