Call for applications for the awarding of twelve scholarships to students admitted with SAT or ACT certification to the first year of a bachelor's degree or single-cycle master's degree program at Luiss University for the 2024/2025 academic year

As part of its initiative to value excellent students, Luiss University is offering **twelve scholarships** earmarked for students with SAT or ACT certification who have applied for direct admission to the first year of a bachelor's degree or single-cycle master's degree program in the 2024/2025 academic year.

The scholarships consist of a **50% partial waiver of the University's annual tuition fee** and can be renewed for the entire standard duration of the degree program.

1. Awarding of the Scholarship

Two rankings will be drawn up for the purpose of awarding the scholarship:

- the first ranking, which will award six partial waivers, of which four to the best of the students holding SAT certification and two to the best of the students holding ACT certification, will be for all applications submitted **from 15 November 2023 to 12 noon on 31 January 2024**;
- the second ranking, which will award a further six partial waivers, of which four to the best of the students holding SAT certification and two to the best of the students holding ACT certification, will be for all applications submitted from 1 February 2024 to 12 noon on 31 May 2024.

The rankings will be determined based on the SAT or ACT scores in descending order irrespective of the degree program chosen. In the case of a tie, preference will be accorded to applications in the order in which they were submitted.

Any scholarships not allocated to one category may be allocated to the other.

2. Incompatibility

The aid envisaged by this competition is incompatible with other tuition fee waivers or scholarships held for any reason whatsoever, except for those awarded by Italian or foreign institutions designed to

support, through periods abroad, a student's education for the academic years covered by this competition.

3. Renewal of the Scholarship

The scholarship will be renewed for the entire standard duration of the degree program on condition that the student, by the end of the summer exam session of the first year and subsequent years, has earned at least 70% of the education credits (*CFU*) required under their study plan for graduation purposes and has a weighted average grade of not less than 27/30.

4. Revocation

The aid envisaged by this competition will be revoked upon the occurrence of any one of the following:

- the student fails to enroll at Luiss University for the first year of a bachelor's degree or single-cycle master's degree program for the 2024/2025 academic year;
- the student no longer fulfills the merit requirements necessary for renewal for the second year, as specified in the preceding Article 3;
- the student enrolls as an off-track or repeating student;
- the student discontinues their studies;
- the student transfers to another university.

5. Submission of Applications and Publication of the Outcome

Applications to participate in this competition can be submitted, using the online form available at the Financial Aid webpages:

- from 15 November 2023 to 12 noon CET on 31 January 2024, or
- from 1 February 2024 to 12 noon CET on 31 May 2024.

The application form envisages the sending of the relevant SAT or ACT certification by way of an attachment, under penalty of exclusion from the competition.

Students may apply only once opting for the first or second ranking, regardless of the date of admission to Luiss University.

The communication regarding the awarding of the aid will be sent:

by 15 March 2024 to the students who **<u>filled out and submitted</u>** the online application form **by 12 noon on 31 January 2024**;



by 30 June 2024 to the students who <u>filled out and submitted</u> the online application form **by 12 noon on 31 May 2024**.

Only complete applications received by the deadline will be considered. Luiss University disclaims any liability in relation to applications that are not received due to technical issues or reasons attributable to third parties.
