Important Rules

- This study plan is designed for students taking part in the mentioned Double Degree Program and spending the academic year 2024/2025 at NHH.
- The list of courses to be taken abroad may be subject to changes should the academic offer at NHH be amended.
- Interested students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the double degree program. Changes to the study plan are usually not possible. Any request in this sense must be conveyed to the International Development Office and the Academic Coordinators, that will evaluate the request.
- The listed exams must be taken and passed in the academic year indicated in the scheme (not after). Any possible change must be formally authorized by the Academic Commission.
- During the mobility, students will be subject to the rules of NHH, including those related to exams, available retakes and grading.
- At the end of the program, if compliant with both Luiss and NHH academic requirements, students will obtain both the Master's Degree in Economics and Business Administration (issued by NHH) and the Master's Degree in Strategic Management (issued by Luiss).

Thesis

- Students will complete their thesis during their mobility period at NHH (2024/2025) with two supervisors: one from each university.
- Students must respect the thesis procedures and deadlines from both institutions. Each institution will grade the final thesis according to its own standards.
- Students are reminded that they are required to comply with the Luiss regular procedure
 regarding the thesis assignment, registration for the degree exam and upload of the thesis. For
 further information, please check the <u>following page</u>.
- Students will be required to submit their thesis to NHH and defend it orally at Luiss, according to the following timeline:
 - Submit the thesis to NHH by June 1
 - O Submit and defend at Luiss in the Autumn graduation session (October-November)
- Both supervisors have to approve the proposal, which must meet the standards of both institutions.
