Shortening of Program for the Master's Degree in Government, Administration and Politics





Students enrolled in the profile of Administrative Law, who wish to enroll by **shortening of program** to the II year (**A.Y. 2025/2026**) of the Master's Degree in **Government, Administration and Politics** – **Major in Government and Administration** must choose and pass during their V year (A.Y. 2024/2025) the elective OR additional courses of <u>Diritto delle assemblee elettive</u> and <u>Scienza politica</u>. Students can choose these courses in the following ways:

- by selecting <u>Diritto delle assemblee elettive</u> and/or <u>Scienza politica</u> as elective courses through the Web Self Service within the time periods provided for the choice of elective courses;
- by submitting a request to <u>segreteria@luiss.it</u>, within the time periods provided for the choice of additional courses, to have <u>Diritto delle</u> <u>assemblee elettive</u> and/or <u>Scienza politica</u> added in their study plan as additional courses "excluded by the weighted average". If passed, these additional courses will be valid for the sole purpose of enrolling by said shortening of program, thus the grades will not be counted in the weighted average and the credits (CFU) associated with it will not be part of the required credits for earning the degree.

Profile Law and Economics of Business



Shortening of Program for the Master's Degree in Administration, Finance and Control

Students enrolled in the profile of Law and Economics of Business, who wish to enroll by **shortening of program** to the II year (**A.Y. 2025/2026**) of the Master's Degree in **Administration, Finance and Control** must choose and pass during their V year (A.Y. 2024/2025) <u>Matematica per le scienze giuridiche</u>, <u>Statistica per le scienze giuridiche</u> and <u>Contabilità e bilancio</u> in the following ways:

- > 3 additional courses requested at <u>segreteria@luiss.it</u> within the time periods provided for the choice of additional courses (if 2 elective courses are chosen among the ones offered for the profile);
- > 2 elective courses selected through the Web Self Service within the time periods provided for the choice of elective courses and 1 additional course requested at segreteria@luiss.it within the time periods provided for the choice of additional courses;
- ➤ 1 elective course among <u>Matematica per le scienze giuridiche</u> <u>Statistica per le scienze giuridiche</u> <u>Contabilità e bilancio</u> + 1 elective course among the ones offered for the profile selected through the Web Self Service within the time periods provided for the choice of elective courses and 2 additional courses requested at <u>segreteria@luiss.it</u> within the time periods provided for the choice of additional courses.

If passed, the additional courses will be valid for the sole purpose of enrolling by said shortening of program, thus the grades will not be counted in the weighted average and the credits (CFU) associated with it will not be part of the required credits for earning the degree.

Core Abroad/Elective Abroad





If you wish to take a core course and/or elective course while studying abroad in the context of a Double Degree, a Structured Partnership, LLM, an International Exchange Program, the Free Mover Program or a Summer School and to sit the associated exam, you must select the general option Core Abroad and/or Elective Abroad.

The exam - if passed - will be included in your academic record and you will be awarded the number of credits that your degree program specifications attribute to core/electives.

It should be noted that it is necessary that courses have already been approved in accordance with the procedures laid down for every mobility program.

Should the exam for the core and/or elective course taken abroad not be passed, you must inform the Student Office of the exam that you intend to take at Luiss, in substitution of Core Abroad and/or Elective Abroad, from among the courses that have been activated and, only for the electives, that are not already full.



Additional Courses



This choice is not compulsory: you can choose 0, 1 or 2 of these courses.



Additional courses, if not taken, can be removed from the study plan.

The grade earned in an additional course (chosen from the list offered for your degree program) is included in the weighted grade point average in thirtieths.

It is not possible to write the thesis on a subject taken as an additional course.

If an additional course has been taken and registered in the academic booklet, it cannot be considered among the credits eligible for the awarding of the degree title (basic/core/elective courses or other activities).





Notes



If core courses/elective courses/other activities or language courses have already been included in your career (exams recognized upon transferring from another University/changing degree programs/shortening/master, exams taken during mobility, brought forward, etc.), you must confirm them when you fill in your study plan. It is not possible to select other courses and take other exams instead of these already recognized or taken.
