Important Rules

- This study plan is designed for students taking part in the above mentioned Double Degree Program and spending the academic year 2024/2025 at UT Capitole.
- Interested students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the double degree program. Changes to the study plan are usually not possible and any request in this sense must be conveyed to the International Development Office that cannot guarantee its feasibility.
- The list of courses to be taken abroad may be subject to changes should the academic offer at UT Capitole be amended.
- The listed exams must be taken and passed in the academic year indicated in the scheme (not after). Any possible change must be formally authorized by the Academic Commission.
- During the mobility, students will be subject to the rules of UT Capitole.
- In accordance with the academic regulations in place at UT Capitole, students are not allowed to repeat or retake exams. Moreover, students need to have a minimum average grade of 10/20 in order to graduate at Toulouse.
- At the end of the program, if compliant with both Luiss and UT Capitole academic requirements, students will obtain both the Master mention Droit Public parcours – type Droit de l'Environment (issued by UT Capitole) and the Master's Degree in Law, Digital Innovation and Sustainability (issued by Luiss).

Thesis

- Students will complete their theses during their mobility period at UT Capitole (2024/2025), with two supervisors, one from each university.
- Students must respect the thesis procedures and deadlines from both institutions. Each institution will grade the final thesis according to its own standards.
- Each supervisor has to approve the proposal, which must meet the standards of both institutions.
- Students will be required to have passed all courses and obtained all credits prior to defending
 their defend their thesis at Luiss, while students will be able to submit and defend their thesis in
 UT Capitole prior to completing all their coursework, according to UT Capitole's rules and
 procedures.
- Students will submit their theses to UT Capitole by the last week of August¹ and will defend the thesis in Toulouse in early September.
- Students will defend the thesis at Luiss in the Autumn graduation session (October/November).

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• Students are reminded that they are required to comply with the Luiss regular procedure regarding the thesis assignment, registration for the degree exam and upload of the thesis.
