



Study Plan LL.M. Educational Program with UC Law San Francisco

Important Rules

- This study plan is designed for students taking part in the mentioned LL.M. Educational Program and spending the academic year 2025-2026 at UC Law San Francisco. The list of courses to be taken abroad may be subject to changes should the academic offer at UC Law SF be amended.
- Interested students are required to read and understand this study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the LL.M. Educational Program. Changes to the study plan are usually not possible and any request in this sense must be conveyed to the International Development Office and the academic coordinator.
- During the mobility, students will be subject to the rules of the partner university.
- At the end of the program, if compliant with both Luiss and UC Law SF academic requirements, students will obtain both the LL.M. Degree (issued by UC Law SF) and the Single Cycle Master's Degree in Law (issued by Luiss).

Study plan

LL.M. at UC Law San Francisco is 24 USA credits¹ (48 ECTS taught courses). Transfer credits with a 2:1 ratio.

During the V year, students will study at UC Law SF in one of the following LL.M.:

- an **LL.M. program in Dispute Resolution and Legal Process**, open to students majoring in Diritto Civile;
- an **LL.M. program in Environmental Law**, open to students majoring in Diritto Amministrativo and in Law and Innovation;
- an **LL.M. program in International Business and Trade**, open to students majoring in Diritto internazionale, Law and Innovation, Diritto Societario e Tributario, Diritto ed Economia delle Imprese, Diritto Civile;
- an **LL.M. program in Health Law and Policy**, open to students majoring in Diritto Amministrativo and in Law and Innovation;
- an **LL.M. program in International Law and Human Rights**, open to students majoring in Diritto Internazionale;
- an **LL.M. program in Taxation**, open to students majoring in Diritto Societario e Tributario.
- an **LL.M. program in Criminal Law** open to students majoring in Diritto penale
- an **LL.M. program in Science, Technology & Intellectual Property** open to students majoring in Law in innovation, Diritto ed Economia delle Imprese

Thesis and Graduation

- Students will complete the thesis for UC Law SF following the Partner University deadlines, during the mobility period.
- Students will identify a Luiss supervisor and will need to follow the regular [Luiss procedure and deadlines](#) for the graduation at Luiss.
- Once returned to Luiss, they will defend the Master thesis at Luiss in July, in October / November (depending on the availability of transcript of records), or March/April.

Grade Conversion and Conversion Table

The academic activities recognized by the partner university will be transferred according to a Block Transfer Recognition.

During the V year the student will follow courses and take exams at the Partner University, in order to receive the LL.M. Degree. Upon his/her return, all the courses reported on the "Transcript of Records" issued by the foreign university will be recognized on the Luiss student's career through a Block Transfer Recognition, which will automatically recognize all the courses of the Luiss profile chosen (IV year II semester and V year I and II semester).

Grades will be transferred based on the calculation of the weighted average of the LL.M. grades. The weighted average grade of the courses taken abroad is converted following the grade conversion table (see below). Please note that the LL.M. thesis grade is excluded from the calculation. Grades will not be rounded up under any circumstance.
