



**Public notice inviting expressions of interest for the filling of a vacancy for the position of Full professor for the academic discipline group 12/GIUR-03 – Economics law and financial and agri-food markets law, academic discipline field GIUR-03/A – Economics law, to be filled through recruitment in accordance with Articles 7(5-bis), 7(5-ter) and 7(5-quater) of Law No 240 of 30 December 2010, notice code ART7-GIUR-ORD-01/2025.**

The Rector of Luiss Libera Università Internazionale degli Studi Sociali Guido Carli:

- having regard to Articles 7(5-bis), 7(5-ter) and 7(5-quater) of Law No 240 of 30 December 2010;
- having regard to Luiss University's current Independent Statutes;
- having regard to Luiss University's current General University Regulations;
- having regard to Luiss University's current Code of Ethics;
- having regard to Luiss University's Regulations on the procedure for the recruitment of first-level and second-level professors at Luiss University in implementation of Articles 7, 18 and 24 of Law No 240 of 30 December 2010 and Articles 1(9) and 1(12) of Law No 230 of 4 November 2005;
- having regard to the resolution of the Board of Directors of Luiss University of 12 December 2024 approving the University's 2025-2028 strategic plan;
- having regard to the proposal dated March 11, 2025, of the Council of the Department of Law, having consulted with the Academic Senate through the Rector, designed to provide for teaching and research for the academic discipline group 12/GIUR-03 – Economics law and financial and agri-food markets law, academic discipline field GIUR-03/A – Economics law;
- having regard to the resolution of Luiss University's Executive Committee of March 31, 2025,

**ISSUES THE FOLLOWING NOTICE**

**Article 1**

**Announcement**

Luiss Libera Università Internazionale degli Studi Sociali Guido Carli (hereinafter the "University", "Luiss University" or "Luiss") announces – pursuant to Articles 7(5-bis), 7(5-ter) and 7(5-quater) of Law No 240 of 30 December 2010 and in the manner laid down in Luiss University's current Regulations on the procedure for the recruitment of first-level and second-level professors at Luiss University in implementation of Articles 7, 18 and 24 of Law No 240 of 30 December 2010 and Articles 1(9) and 1(12) of Law No 230 of 4 November 2005 (hereinafter the "Regulations") – the holding of a selection procedure for the recruitment of tenured professors with the following characteristics:

- Number of positions: 1;
- Full professor;
- Department of Law;
- Academic discipline group 12/GIUR-03 – Economics law and financial and agri-food markets law;
- Academic discipline field GIUR-03/A – Economics law;
- Notice code ART7-GIUR-ORD-01/2025;
- Teaching needs: the selected candidate will be required to carry out teaching activities coherent with the academic-discipline field of the call, and with the main research goals of the University, the Research Centers, the School of Law, as well as the Undergraduate and Graduate Schools. He/she will have to be able to teach in Italian as well as in English. Teaching activities, supplementary teaching, and student services will total 350 hours annually, with 120 hours per year dedicated to classroom teaching for full-time positions, or 250 hours annually, with 90 hours allocated to classroom teaching for part-time positions. The teaching activity will be carried out within the framework of the educational program of the School of Law of the University as part of the planning of undergraduate, single-cycle and master's degree courses, and will consist in carrying out lectures, exercises and theoretical-practical activities, assistance during exams, in any teaching assignments assigned as an institutional task, according to the provisions and within the limits of the law. The teaching activity will be carried out with reference to the relevant academic-discipline field of the call (GIUR- 03/A – Economics Law). The professor must teach courses with particular emphasis on i) Banking law and legislation, financial markets regulation; ii) Credit instruments, financial instruments, and derivative contracts; cryptoassets; iii) Listing on regulated markets, regulation and governance of issuers, public offers (OPA); iv) Supervision of banking and financial markets and relations between authorities; v) Insolvency and systemic crises in banking and financial institutions; vi) Decentralized finance, fintech, and artificial intelligence.
- Research needs: The selected candidate will be required to carry out scientific research activities coherent with the academic-discipline field of the call, and with the main research goals of the University, the Research Centers, the School of Law, as well as the Undergraduate and Graduate Schools. The research activities should also be carried out from a supranational and comparative perspective, with reference—among other things – to the EU legal framework and the creation of a single capital market. In this context, special attention should be devoted to investor protection, relations between national and European supervisory authorities, as well as alternative dispute resolution systems between businesses and investors. The selected candidate should have the experience and academic maturity to lead and coordinate research groups and to develop, in the aforementioned areas, both post-graduate courses and relationships and exchanges with businesses, public and private institutions, both national and international. The selected candidate should contribute to strengthening the University's presence in the national and international debate, through events of in-depth analysis and scientific dissemination in Italy and abroad, demonstrating an adequate public output in the aforementioned areas (with a focus on both profit and non-profit entities).



- Third mission needs: the professor must contribute to enhancing the University's presence in local, national, and international contexts through the organization of culturally and socially significant events in Italy and abroad, including those with a focus on non-profit entities.
- The remuneration payable to the winner under this public notice, pursuant to Article 8 of Law No 240/2010 and Decree of the President of the Republic No 232 of 15 December 2011, is that envisaged for Full professors, having regard to the winner's career position and their working hours commitment.

## Article 2

### Requirements for the Submission of Expressions of Interest and Exclusions

Expressions of interest may be submitted by:

- a. professors who have been working for at least five years at other universities at the level corresponding to that for which the selection procedure has been organised;
- b. scholars regularly engaged abroad in research or teaching who have been holding for at least five years an equivalent academic position at foreign universities, determined on the basis of the table of correspondence between Italian and foreign academic positions compiled by the Ministry.

The selection procedure referred to in Article 1 is open also to research managers and established researchers (*primi ricercatori*) at public research entities provided that they have been in service for at least five years at the entity with which they are affiliated and hold national academic qualification (*abilitazione scientifica nazionale*) for the academic recruitment field (*settore concorsuale*) and the level to which the selection procedure refers. Candidates aspiring to fill the position of first-level professor must meet the requirements laid down in the regulations in force for aspiring commission members for national academic qualification procedures pursuant to Article 16 of Law No 240/2010.

Qualifications must be held as of the closing date for the submission of expressions of interest under this public notice.

The procedure for the awarding of a contract pursuant to this public notice is not open to those who are related, by blood or marriage up to the fourth degree inclusive, to a first-level or second-level professor belonging to the department in respect of which the public notice is issued, the Rector, the General Manager or a member of the University's Board of Directors.

## Article 3

### Expressions of Interest

Expressions of interest as well as the qualifications held and the documents and publications considered useful for the selection procedure must, on pain of exclusion, be submitted electronically using the dedicated computerised platform at the following link:

The computerised platform will necessarily require candidates to have an e-mail address in order to be able to self-register with the system. The candidate must enter all of the required data to generate their expression of interest and attach soft copies of the documents referred to in this public notice. No other form of submitting expressions of interest or documentation with a view to taking part in the selection procedure will be accepted.

By the deadline for the submission of expressions of interest, the system allows candidates to save them in draft mode. The date of electronic submission of the actual expression of interest is certified by the computer system through a receipt that will automatically be sent by e-mail. Upon expiry of the deadline for submission, the system will no longer allow access to and submission of the electronic form. Expressions of interest received after the deadline will not be accepted.

Each expression of interest will be assigned an identification number that, together with the notice code specified on the computerised platform, will have to be quoted in any subsequent correspondence.

The process for filling out and electronically submitting expressions of interest must be completed **by and no later than 2:00 p.m. Central European Summer Time (CEST) on the fifteenth day** running from the day after the date of publication of the notice on the University's website. Should the stated deadline fall on a public holiday, it is extended to the next business day.

The submission of the expression of interest to take part in the selection procedure must be formally completed by choosing one of the methods of signature set out in the "digital signature" page of the dedicated computerised platform.

The service may be temporarily suspended for technical reasons.

Should the IT systems adopted by the University suffer a proven technical glitch thereby making submission of expressions of interest impossible through the platform, the University reserves the right to accept expressions of interest in ways other than that indicated in the previous paragraphs.

In their expression of interest, candidates must clearly state under their own responsibility:

- the department, academic discipline group and academic discipline field of the selection procedure in which they wish to take part;
- name and surname;
- gender;
- place and date of birth;
- residence;
- nationality;
- contact address for the purposes of the public notice;
- personal tax number (solely for Italian residents);
- e-mail address chosen for the purposes of the public notice;
- telephone number;
- fulfilment of the requisites referred to in Article 2 above.



The following must be attached to the expression of interest, through uploading them to the system:

- project proposal in relation to the teaching, research and third mission needs by filling in form Annex A;
- curriculum vitae (including a list of publications and details of teaching, third mission, service, institutional and organisational activities);
- any documentation proving the equivalence between Italian and foreign academic positions (in this case candidates must attach a certificate of service, translated also into Italian, issued by the institution to which they belong specifying the position held, the date that the position was taken up and any equivalence with the corresponding academic position in Italian universities);

The e-mail address given by candidates in their expression of interest and Luiss University's website constitute the official means of communication relating to this selection procedure and all related matters, unless otherwise specified. #### Article 4

##### Evaluation of Expressions of Interest

The correspondence of the project proposals submitted by the candidate to the teaching, research or third mission needs expressed by the Department will be the object of evaluation.

The Academic Senate, in order to carry out the evaluation, may appoint and avail itself of an Examining Commission composed of three first-level professors in the case of recruitment of first-level professors or at least one first-level professor and second-level professors in the case of recruitment of second-level professors. In all cases at least one member of the Commission must belong to the academic discipline group that the selection concerns.

The Academic Senate proposes to the Executive Committee the recruitment of the successful candidate indicated by the Examining Commission. The Academic Senate, alternatively, may decide not to proceed with the recruitment by reasoned resolution. The Executive Committee ratifies the recruitment within 30 days of the Academic Senate's resolution. The Rector will issue a decree recruiting the professor.
